shower is equally luxurious. Amenities abound in the tile-clad space, including a bench seat and three showerheads: a handheld wand, a fixed head, and a rainlike spray overhead.

Langford's next step also emphasized the importance of blending function with flair. She removed an inefficient linen closet and replaced it with a tall and narrow paneled armoire lined with doors, drawers, and open shelves. The unit's angled shape eases traffic flow yet allows for a large amount of storage.

The armoire's soft green custom glazed and painted finish fits perfectly with the room's soothing green-gray color scheme. Porcelain tiles blanket the floor and part of the walls. Green- and brown-flecked granite tops the creamy vanity cabinetry. "The bath is wonderfully neutral and will stand the test of time," Langford says. "It feels relaxing and calming." **KBI**
